

Instructions: How to tie a western saddle (except Barefoot model Nevada)

Step 1: Put on the saddle and fix the western girth to the off-billet on the right side of the saddle.

Step 2: To fix the girth to the left side, firstly pull the tie-strap (punched long lash through the buckle of the girth from back to front.

Step 3 Now the tie-strap must be pulled from the front to the back into the saddle's D-ring. Afterwards please lace the tie-strap into the girth buckle again, from back to front.

Step 4: Fasten the belt is pulling on the tie-strap until the saddle is fixed.

Step 5: If the desired tension is achieved fix the pin of the girth buckle into the nearest tie-strap hole.

Step 6: The pin must be fixed by raising the top layer of the tie-strap. Securing the pin is important to keep the saddle safe in place.

Step 7: Secure the end of the tie-strap into the saddle's tie-strap holder.
